



# Baby Hand Socks

## Materials

- 1 skein Dale of Norway Baby Ull (180 yards/165 meters per skein)
- Size US 2 needles (or size to obtain gauge)
- Cable needle (or small dpn)
- Row counter
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
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**Size:** 0-6 months

**Gauge:** 7.5 sts = 1" in stockinette

## Stitch Guide

- C3B – slip 3 sts to cable needle, hold in back of work, K3 sts, K3 sts from cable needle
- C3F – slip 3 sts to cable needle, hold in front of work, K3 sts, K3 sts from cable needle

## Directions

### *Cuff*

CO 40 sts, arrange on 3 DPNs. Join, being careful not to twist.

Work K2/P2 rib for 1”

### *Left Mitt*

Setup: K1 st from needle 1 to needle 3. This is the new beginning of your round. Arrange sts so that there are 20 sts on needle 1, and 10 each on needles 2 and 3.

Rounds 1 & 2 – K5, P2, K6, P2, K to end

Round 3 – K5, P2, C3B, P2, K to end

Rounds 4-7 – same as Round 1

Repeat these 7 rounds until work measures 3” from CO edge.

Decreasing:

Round 1:

- Needle 1: SSK, work to last 2 sts on needle 1, K2tog
- Needle 2: SSK, work to end of needle
- Needle 3 – work to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Round 2: work even in patt

Repeat these two rounds until 16 sts remain. Kitchener stitch remaining sts.

### *Right Mitt*

Work as for Left Mitt, but substitute C3F for C3B.

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
